

August 2004 - Highlights

Beat 1: Maana Camp, Banarsi and Airport area.

Feedback, problems and police commitment:-

Over the problem of due to the roaming of animals in the road and the dog biting the Police have written application to the Panchayat to take action. As a result Panchayat have made public announcement through out the streets ordering the resident to to keep their animals under control.

(The CLG members are satisfied by the Police action.)

To the problem of illegal liquor selling & gambling, the Police have made action and arrested some of the person. Due to these actions the CLG Memb. Said that the illegal selling of liquor & gambling 'satta-patti' have decreased marginally although not stope completely, and now it is not happening openly as it had earlier.

(The CLG members are satisfied by the Police action, but said it should be continue.)

Small problems should be solved within the Beats by the Beat Officer, the complaints to the police should get Police protection if needs. The liquor, cigrates, pan masala, etc selling near the school should be stopped. There should be Police surveillance during the opening & closing of school. Police replied in the affirmative to these demands.

The person who were under the watch by Police as anti-social elements, if not engaged in mischiveous & illegal activities since a quite satisfactory time should be removed from the list 'Nigrani Badmaash' by Police in consultation & consensus with CLG members, and there should be atleast one traffic class or traffic rules related circular in every high schools in this area. The Beat Officer said that they cooperate and will talk to higher authority.

Beat 2: Dharampura, Nakati, Baroda.

Action taken by the Police over the problem raised by CLG Members and CLG's feedback:-

Nakati Village-

Over the problem of illegal sale of liquor in the village its selling is stoped before the Police takes any action , and happened because of the message of the meeting which gone to these person engaged.

(CLG members were satisfied on the Police actions).

Since over the problem of dirtiness around Hand Pump the Panchayat had not sent any written complaint to the Police, as aked, therefore no had been taken by the Police.

(CLG memb. Said they will now send application first to Panchayat and if no action done then they will send to Police).

Over the illegal encroachment on the public path, it is found that its not a pubice path but the part of land of group of villagers , and secondly they have not made any application to Police.

(CLG memb have taken back this complaint and said they will solve in Panchayat level)

Baroda Village-

Over the happening of mischeveous & illegal activities in the place 'Bhata' near the village, the CLG said that these have stoped automatically while the Police said that they never found any during their patrolling.

(CLG memb are not fully satisfied and said it should be under vigilance).

Dharampura Village-

To the issue of ill maintenance of road crossing the village, the PWD have started improving it. The Police said if they will be given application by Panchayat will be forwarded to PWD.

(CLG memb said that they will pressurise the PWD through Panchayat).

To stop the playing of cards with money (gambling) issue the Police said they have instructed those who were engaged once to stop it.

(CLG memb said that it is not sufficient and more action should be done)

Problems & issue raised by CLG Members and Assertion & Commitment made by the Police over these:-

Nakati Village-

The Police should take action to over the people making dirtiness around Hand Pump. The Police Officer asked for written complaint over which they take action

Dharampura Village-

(1) They want Police action to stop gambelling (cards playing with money)

{Commitment: The Police officer said they will take action only on those who are playing cards with money not over who are playing just for entertainment.}

Baroda Village-

(1) There should be daily Police Patrolling around 5:30 pm.

{Commitment: The Police officer said they will do it.}

Beat 3: Boriakalla, Temri, Doomartari, Dhaneli.

Feedback:-

Doomartarai Village-

Over the problem of pollution by a Factory beside the School, Police have taken sample from the factory and they had instructed the Manager to check the Pollution. But the sample which Police had taken is not yet given to any Pollution Checking Agency/ Authority.

(CLG members were not much satisfied on the Police actions and said more prompt and effective action should be taken.)

To the problem of Pollution by a 'Poha' Mill in the village, the Police have given direction to the Manager of the Mill to check smoke emitting out from the factory.

(CLG memb were satisfied by the Police action).

To the Police Patrolling issue, the Police said that although they were coming to the village daily due to some or other work but particularly for Patrolling they were doing once in 2-3 days.

(CLG memb said are not fully satisfied and want it daily).

Boriakalla Village-

To the problem of 'Satta-Patti' although it has stop, but the gambling 'Passa' is still going. The Police said that they had instructed once in the spot not to play with money.

(CLG members were not much satisfied and want more Police action).

To the problem related to drunker who do chaos in the village, the Police had instructed once .

(CLG memb said that after the Police instruction the incidence had come down but still happens in some days in every week).

Over the problem of gathering of mischievous & anti social elements in a square called 'Gandhi Chowk' the Police have instructed twice in the spot not to make gathering here.

(CLG memb are not fully satisfied and said it should be under vigilance).

Problems & issue raised by CLG Members and Assertion & Commitment made by the Police over these:-

Doomartari Village-

There should be daily Police Patrolling between 5 to 9 pm. in the night.

{Commitment: The Police officer said they will do it.}

The pollution emission from the factory beside the school should be stop, CLG's wants more prompt and effective action by the Police.

{Commitment: The Police Officer said they will now talk to higher authority and take guidance for making quick & effective action to stop pollution}

Boriakalla Village-

They want Police action to stop gambelling 'Passa' and asked that the T.I. Mr Parihar should come to the spot and should once take action.

{Commitment: The Police officer said they will take action and will inform the T.I. Mr Parihar about this}.

CLGs want Police action over drunker who generally made chaos on Sundays between 4 to 6 pm.

{Commitment: The Police officer said they will take action over it.}

CLG memb said that one Hawker 'Thelawala' who do business in the 'Gandhi Chowk' has link with unsocial elements of village, so wants that Police should check him and if he not obeyed the order his place of business should be changed.

{Commitment: The Police Officer said that they will give instruction to that Hawker }.

Dhanelli Village-

CLG memb want Police action to stop illegal selling of liquors in the village.

{Commitment: The Police officer said they will take action to stop illegal selling of liquor in the village. }

CLGs wants Police action over the drunkers who made chaos generally in Sunday between 4 to 7 pm.

{Commitment: The Police officer said they will take action. }

Beat 4: Maana Basti, Maana Coloney, Bhatgaon

Action taken by the Police over the problem raised by CLG Members and CLG's feedback:-

Maana Basti Village-

Over the illegal selling of liquor on National Day and Liquor Banned Day the Police have made immediate action on 15th of August when some villager have inform on telephone.

(CLG members were satisfied on this Police action.)

Over the tenants and outsiders identification registration the Beat Officer has not yet talked to his higher authorities over this issue.

(CLG memb not satisfied and still wants it).

To the Police Patrolling issue, the Police were making daily Patrolling in village at least after the 07th Aug. incidence (which results in blocking of road by villagers as an agitation).

(CLG memb are satisfied and want it to continue).

Bhatgaon Village-

The Police patrolling is not doing daily and happening once in 3 days. Beat Officers giving the reason of lack of staff.

(CLG members were not satisfied and want Police Patrolling daily).

The Police did not made any action over the issue of illegal selling of liquor as they did not received any information regarding the person engaged in this or spot where it is sailing as told by CLG in last meeting.

(CLG memb said that now they will give information about the person & place were illegal selling of liquor is happening and asked Police officer to first instruct the person engaged to stop selling and if not obeyed their order strong action should be taken).

Since the problem of dirtiness around the Hand Pump was due to the gathering of water in temporary path 'Kaccha road' and not due to dropping of garbage etc, thus this problem is void and hence no Police action can be made.

(CLG memb have taken back their complaint).

Problems & issue raised by CLG Members and Assertion & Commitment made by the Police over these:-

Maana Basti Village-

CLG wants that there should be daily Police Patrolling between 11 to 1 am. in the night.

{Commitment: The Police officer said they will do it.}

CLG memb wants one Police Help Centre ‘ Police Sahayta Kendra’ in the village.

{Commitment: The Police Officer said that they will talk to higher authorities in this matter}.

The Tenants & outsiders identification should be registered in Police Station.

{Commitment: The Police Officer said that he will order the ‘Kotwar’ to collect and give these information to P.S. and then they will find the authenticity of whereabouts}

CLG ask for one Traffic Officer to manage traffic in front of School during its opening & closing specially between 11 to 1 pm when the Primary School closes and High School opens in the same building.

{Commitment: The Beat Officer said he will talk to T.I. and higher authorities regarding this}

CLG memb demanded for the Police arrangement in the weekly market ‘ Saptahik Bazar’ which took place in every Sunday between 3 to 6 pm}.

{Commitment: The Beat Officer agreed for this but said he have to take permission from the T.I. Mr Paribar}.

Bhatgaon Village-

They want Police action to stop illegal selling of liquor , but said at first the Police should instruct the person engaged to stop this and if not obeyed Police should take strong action.

{Commitment: The Police officer said they will take action to stop illegal selling of liquor}.

CLG memb ask Police to make daily Potrolling between 7 to 9 pm.

{Commitment: The Beat officer said he will at least send one constable daily in Patrolling .}

Police Expectations from the Community:-

Police wants that people should help them by becoming witness.

Police expects that the Complainant should not turn back and should cooperate them when the Police is making action over his/her complaint.

Comments

The turn up of the CLG memb is low because there was delay by the Police Officers in messaging them and due to this no memb from the village Maana Coloney came. Another reason for the low turn up was that the CLG were busy in the rituals of death in the village. I had discussed with the CLGs that in which topic they want to get knowledge & awareness related to social problem which can be discussed in up coming meetings. They told me the following topics- Health related, Women’s issues, Child marriage & Child rights, Liquors & Drug de addiction, Labors issues, ‘Tonhi’ & other prejudices, Agriculture information, etc..
