

'Nukad-Natak' at village BARODA:-

- **Date-** 20th March 2005 (Sunday).
- **Timings-** 5:30 pm - 6:30 pm
- **Beat No.-II.**
- **No. of CLGs participants-** 3.
- **No. of Police Personnel present-** 1
- **No. of viewers-** Around 150-200 people.
- **Venue-** At '*Kala Manch*', Village Baroda, Mana Police Station area, Raipur.

- **Role of Village Baroda Panchayat in the programe-** The Sarpanch Mr Shukla Bandhe (aged around 25-30 years, & the Deputy Sarpanch helped out in propagation/ announcement only. Cooperation by the Sarpanch was not satisfactory, may be due to the reason that the most active CLG of this village Mr Ram Nath (aged 70 yrs) had a bad relation with the Sarpanch lobby.

- **Role of CLGs-** The CLG's members arranged the sound system etc for the play. The CLG's also helped in the filling up of the evaluation forms.

- **Role of Mana Police personnel** - Today again Mana P.S. team was engaged in the program of Mr Praveen Togadiya while the other police personnel were waiting for the arrival of the Home Minister flight at the Mana airport. Thus police presence was reduced to one.

- **The queries by the villagers-** Only 4-5 villagers came to me after the programme and asked that when will the meetings will organize in their village and CLGs backed by some villagers told that illegal liquor & gambling again started here.

- **Comments-**
 - The play was first scheduled to be conducted in this village on 19th March Saturday the at 7:00 pm, but after the Nakti & Boriakala incidence it was postponed for a day as there is a direct tension between CLG & Sarpanch lobby and it was decided that the play should be delayed for a day
 - A CLG member (aged around 65-70 yrs) is the one of the most active CLGs. He was twice elected as the member of Village Defence Committee. He is always cooperative in the Beat meetings.
 - One of the women CLG of this village is also active.
