

‘Nukad-Natak’ at village BHATGAON:-

- **Date-** 13th March, 2005 (Sunday)
- **Timings-** The programme started at 3:00 pm while ended at 4:00 pm (This play here was first scheduled to conduct on 12th March at 7:00 pm but was postponed yesterday only before the scheduled time due to the late arrival of the artists).
- **Beat No.-IV.**
- **No. of CLGs participants-** 4.
- **No. of Police Personnel present-** 5..
- **No. of viewers-** Around 150 people.
- **Venue-** At ‘Kala Manch’ also called ‘Jaitya Khamb’, Village Bhatgaon, Mana Police Station area, Raipur.

- **Role of Village Bhatgaon Panchayat in the programme-** The Sarpanch of this village is a lady, Mrs Bhola Bai Gitlahre (women reserved seat) who is the also the mother of the Deputy Chairman of this Beat-IV CLG Mr Gangadhar Gitlahre. She along with her son helped a great deal in organising the programme.

- **Role of CLGs-** Here 2 CLGs (Deputy Sarpanch and the son of Sarpanch) helped in the arrangement of sound system for the play, clearing the stage, and in the announcement/ propaganda. The CLG Mr Gangadhar Gitlahre after the play informed the villagers about how the meetings are conducted with the police personnel & the problem that could be discussed in the meeting. The CLGs also helped in filling the survey questionnaire of ‘Public perception of Mana Police & Nukad-Natak evaluation’.

- **Role of Mana Police personnel** - Along with Beat-IV officer HC Mr Lahre 4 others HC & Constable were present during the program. After the end of play the Beat Officer told people not to hesitate in telling & sharing problems with police and also gave away the information about the process & methodology of community policing in Mana. They as well asked the villager to help them in witness, support during accidents, crime information & helping in police during raids. Each police personnel also introduced themselves.

- **The queries by the villagers-** Here the villagers did not raise many queries & question before or after the play, although some inquired about the CGHRC , its telephone no. & address (which is as per script supposed to be told after the end of play).
