

## **‘Nukad-Natak’ at village MANA COLONEY :-**

- **Date-** 20<sup>th</sup> March, 2005 (Sunday)
- **Timings-** 7:30 pm - 8:15 pm
- **Beat No.-IV.**
- **No. of CLGs participants-** 3.
- **No. of Police Personnel present-** 5..
- **No. of viewers-** Around 200 people.
- **Venue-** At main Square, Village Mana Coloney, Mana Police Station area, Raipur.
  
- **Role of Village Mana Coloney Panchayat in the programme-** This is the only village of Mana which doesn't have its own Panchayat, it comes under the Panchayat of Mana Basti. Since as the bidding of the market at Mana Basti was going on, the Sarpanch of this area Mr Rameshwar Patel was busy in that bidding so he didn't turn up, although he did inform that he will come straight to the Mana Colony village as soon as this bidding was over.
  
- **Role of CLGs-** Here the 3 CLGs along with the announcement/ propaganda, they did the arrangement of the light & mat. The CLGs also helped in filling the survey questionnaire of 'Public perception of Mana Police & Nukad-Natak evaluation'.
  
- **Role of Mana Police personnel** - Along with S.I Mr Tigga, there were 4 other police personnel were present in the program. Beat-IV officer HC Mr Lahre 4 others HC & Constable were present during the program. While this Beat-IV officer Mr Ram Nath Lahre didn't turn up because as he did the last night duty and was present in the P.S. till 4 pm. He had gone home to take rest
  
- **The Process adopted for the Nukad-Natak-** This village looked quite peaceful so before the program the problems & queries of the villagers & CLGs were discussed with the police. After the program the villagers were informed about the meaning of this play "Hum Sub Hain Police" and its relation to every citizen. After the end of 'Nukad-Natak' CHRI was introduced and the working and the role of CGHRC was explained. Then the S.I Mr Tigga introduced himself and told how the meetings conducts, what are problems that could be solved in these meetings while asking the villagers what are the expectations of the police to the villager and also asked to take help of Police whenever they required.
  
- **The queries by the villagers-** Here the villagers & CLGs did not raised many queries & question. Some of the queries & problems raised by villagers were-
  - Gambling & police actions.
  - They told that police patrolling is very poor since last some months.
  
- **Comments-**
  - Regarding the spot selection for the play we faced difficulty. Before a day when the program was first scheduled to take place at 5:30 pm it was

decided to do it in the premises of Govt School but today as the program was postponed to 6:30 pm. In the beginning the CLGs selected the premises of temple of Goddess Durga (or some Goddess) which is located at the heart of village (where most of the cultural program. conducts), but it was refused because the temple is a sensitive area in this Begali dominated village. So, instead it was decided to do it in the ground in front of temple.

- As this village is full of the Bangladeshi migrant, it seems that this is one of the reason why administration is not willing to form a separate Panchayat of their own as well this is also the reason to lack of facilities like electricity, etc.
