# COUNTER AFFIDAVIT FILED ON BEHALF OF STATE OF UTTAR PRADESH IN COMPLIANCE OF ORDER DATED 1.6.2021


I, Alok Singh son of Late Shri Bheem Singh aged about 54 years, is working on the post of Superintendent of Jail, District Jail Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh, do hereby solemnly affirm and state on oath as under:

1. I am working on the post of Superintendent of Jail, District Jail Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh. I have been authorized by State Government to file this affidavit on behalf of the State Government. I am competent to file this Counter Affidavit. I am well conversant with the facts and circumstances of the case being stated hereinafter as gathered from the records of the case.

The present affidavit is being filed in compliance of order dated 1.6.2021 passed by the Hon'ble Court in I.A.No.63602 of 2021 filed by Sachin Yadav.

- 3. It is pertinent to mention that on behalf of the State of Uttar Pradesh an affidavit was submitted before this Hon'ble Court in compliance of orders dated 23.3.2020 and 7.4.2020, hereinafter referred to as the 'First Affidavit'. In this affidavit it was stated that a High Power Committee comprising of Senior Judge at Lucknow Bench of the Hon'ble Allahabad High Court, Shri Avanish Awasthi, Additional Chief Secretary (Home & Jails) Government of U.P. and Shri Anand Kumar, IPS, Director General Prisons, U.P.
- 4. The High Powered Committee issued following directions: -
  - (i) Classified prisoners into three categories viz. (A) convicts, (B)
     under trial prisoners and (C) Juveniles in conflict with law
  - (ii) Laid down criteria for release of the prisoners of each category.
  - (iii) The "Under Trial Review Committee" contemplated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Re Inhuman Conditions in 1382 prisons, (2016) 3 SCC 700 shall meet every week and take decision in consultation with the concerned District Authorities as per the said judgment.
  - (iv) Under trail prisoners facing criminal cases in which maximum sentence is 7 years, whose bail applications have already been rejected by the Sessions Court and pending before the Hon'ble High Court be also released.
  - (v) It was clarified that the term "Under Trial Prisoners" shall include both types of prisoners who are in judicial custody under Sections 167 and 309 of the Cr.P.C.
  - (vi) The Sessions/Additional Sessions Judge while considering interim bail application of under trial prisoner may keep in

- mind that the offence should not relates to Terrorist activities, organize crime detrimental to national interest.
- (vii) Convicted prisoners detained in jail belonging to other States, if release on parole would face difficulties to reach their native place and therefore such type of convicted persons may not be released on parole henceforth.
- It was also stated in the affidavit that upto 11.04.2020 the State Government has released a total of 12873 prisoners on parole for a period of 8 weeks from various prisons across the State.
- 6. It was also averred that the State Government issued G.O.No.689JAL/22-3-2020-800(30)/2020 dated 01.04.2020 thereby directing to release 1364 convicts subject to submitting personal bond and had undertaking that the convicts will report to the Jail Authorities at the end of 8 weeks of granting special parole.



The High Power Committee also issued directions regarding sanitizations tunnels, manufacturing 5,32,000 face mask and other necessary directions as required in the interest of the prisoners.

9. The Additional Chief Secretary of the State of Uttar Pradesh vide letter No.794J.L./22-3-2021-800(30)/20/21T.C.-I dated 28.05.2021 addressed to Director General of Police, Inspector General of Prisons Administration and Reforms Services U.P. Lucknow informing that 364 prisoners mentioned in the list be released on special parole of 60 days on submitting personal bond/personal bail



bond giving undertaking that they will surrendered before the Prisoner Authorities on expiry of the period of parole.

- The Hon'ble Court vide order dated 7.5.2021 issued directions in the matter viz.:-
  - (i) The Police authorities should not unnecessary arrest the accused persons
  - (ii) The police while making arrest of the accused is required to comply with the directions contained in case of Arnesh Kumar vs. State of Bihar reported in 2014 (8) SCC 273.
  - (iii) The High Power Committee constituted by the State Governments/Union Territories shall consider release of prisoners by adopting the guidelines (such as inter alia, SOP laid down by the Nalsa) followed in the last year.
  - (iv) High Powered Committee should forthwith release all the inmates who had been released earlier pursuant to order dated 23.3.2020 passed by this Court by imposing appropriate conditions.
  - (v) Those inmates who may granted parole pursuant to earlier order of this court should be again granted a parole of 90 days in order to tide over the pandemic.
  - (vi) All decisions of the High Power Committee need to be published on respective State Legal Service Authorities/State Governments/High Courts websites.
  - (vii) To ensure that proper medical facilities are provided to all prisoners. The spread of Covid-19 virus should be controlled in the prisons by regular testing dealt to the prisoners but also



- 11. The directions issued by the Hon'ble Court is being complied with by the concerned authorities in leter and spirit.
- 12. The Hon'ble Court vide order dated 1.6.2021 on I.A.No.63602 of 2021 has passed the following directions: -
  - (i) The State Governments are directed to file an affidavit within a period of four weeks furnishing information about the number of prisoners released pursuant to the order dated 7.5.2021.
  - (ii) The State Governments shall also provide the information relating to number of deaths in prison due to Covid-19.
  - (iii) The non-consideration of the pre-mature release of prisoners by this Court in order dated 7.5.2021 shall not deter the competent authorities to consider the pre-mature release of prisoners in accordance with law.

The details of prisoners, found infected, recovered, being treated, died and undergoing treatment detained in 71 jails and 47 makeshift temporary jails was collected for the period upto 29.5.2021. It transpires that as on 29.5.2021 a total of 1,02,924 prisoners were detained in 71 jails in the State and 2871 prisoners were detained in 47 makeshift temporary jails. In this way approximately 1,05,795 prisoners were detained in jail upto 29.5.2021. All the details are being given in the following chart:-



14.3 It is further submitted that from March 2020 to June 2021 due to Covid-19 situation 457 convicted prisoners have been released.



14.5 In pursuance of said guidelines till 28.6.2021 a total of 1,06,965 prisoners are in 71 jails in the State of Uttar Pradesh and a total of 3,419 prisoners are detained in 47 temporary jails. Thus, in total 1,10,384 prisoners are detained in various jails.

- 14.6 In pursuance of orders passed by this Hon'ble Court the prisoners are being released on special parole/interim bail in accordance with the guidelines issued by the High Power Committee.
- 14.7 The up-to-date status of vaccination for prevention from Covid-19 has been given to prisoners detained in different jails in the State of Uttar Pradesh. The status report as on 20.6.2021 are as follows:-

SUBMISSION OF REPORT IN COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER DATED 01.06.2021 PASSED BY HON'BLE SUPREME COURT, NEW DELHI IN SUO MOTO PETITION NO.1/2020 CONTAGION OF COVID 19 VIRUS IN PRISON.

In compliance of the order dated 01.06.2021 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court, New Delhi in Suo Moto Petition No.-1 / 2020 Contagion of Covid 19 Virus in Prison on the above subject, instructions have been given to file affidavit with the following information:

"The 6 State Governments / Union Territories are directed to file an affidavit within a period of four weeks furnishing information about the number of prisoners released pursuant to the order dated 07.05.2021. The State Governments / Union Territories shall also provide information relating to the number of deaths in prisons due to Covid - 19. According to the applicant, pre - mature release of prisoners in exercise of the power under Section 432 Cr.PC would assist decongestion of the over crowded jails. The order dated 07.05. 2021 passed by this Court pertains to parole and interim bail. The applicant has highlighted the disparities in the decisions taken by the High-Powered Committees of various States. o the applicant, the High Powered Committee of Himachal Pradesh has directed that cases of prisoners for premature release can be considered, whereas the High Powered Committees of other States are not considering the issue of pre - mature release of the prisoners.

The Registry is directed to furnish all papers that are filed in this case to the learned 7 Amicus Curiae. The learned counsel appearing for the parties are also directed to provide copies of all I.A.s and connected documents to the learned Amicus Curiae before the next date of hearing."

In compliance with the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the details of the convicted / undertrial prisoners released on special parole / interim bail as on 28.06.2021 are as follows:

It is also worth mentioning here that during the Covid-19 Spread from March 2020 to June 2021, orders for the premature release of a total of 457 convicted prisoners have been passed, in compliance of which a total of 457 prisoners have been released from prisons.

With regard to para-12(11) of IAO filed in the Suo Moto petition in question, it is to be informed that in compliance with the order dated on 04.05.2021 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court, New Delhi in the Writ Petition (Cr) No.155/2021 Bechelal vs. U.P. State and in other connected writ petitions, the Member Secretary, Uttar Pradesh State Legal Services Authority attached the instructions of Hon'ble Executive Chairman, UPSLSA and sent it for guidance. The guidelines have been provided by the minutes/recommendations dated June 09, 2021 and May 21, 2021 of the Member Secretary, Uttar Pradesh State Legal Services Authority, which are being complied with.

Till 28.06.2021, a total of 1,06,965 prisoners are being detained in 72 jails of the State and a total of 3,419 prisoners are detained in 47 working temporary jails, thus about 1,10,384 prisoners in total.

- Thermal screening, medical examination and RTPCR / antigen test are being done continuously for the examination of Covid-19 of all the prisoners at the time of admission to the temporary jails built in the districts of the state before entering the main jails.
- According to the instructions of the Government, in all the 72 functional prisons of the Prisons Department, arrangements have been made for the Covid help desk for the investigation and rescue of Covid-19 and the knowledgeable staff has been posted on the basis of roster. Availability of sanitizer, thermal scanner and pulse oximeter has been ensured at the Covid help desk.
- All the newcomer prisoners are being kept in quarantine barracks for 14 days as per the medical advisory.
- New admission prisoners, who are found to have the possibility of Covid-19 infection, are being admitted to the permanent prison after first being tested negative after being kept in a temporary jail.
- While allocating the budget for the arrangement of handwash, soap, sanitizer for the use of prisoners, personnel and visitors of the prisons, instructions have been given for proper arrangements as before.

- Hon'ble High Court, Allahabad, in the sequence of the orders circulated by the Registrar General, for the remand and trial of the prisoners hearing is being done continuously through video conferencing as before.
- To prevent the spread of Covid-19 infection, the arrangement for meeting the prisoners with their families is already postponed. Keeping in view that there is no depression in the prisoners, the frequency and facility of PCO, PNT phone, CUG talk has been increased.
- Supervision of all the works is being done 24 hours continuously by forming a team under the supervision of Deputy Inspector General of Prisons (M) / Nodal Officer.
- Awareness is being spread among prisoners and personnel for prevention of infection through flex, banner, public address system and jail radio in prisons.
   The prisoners are constantly being motivated for washing hands and social distancing.
- Everyday cleaning and sanitization work is being done in each jail.

- To prevent the spread of Covid-19 infection, the arrangement for meeting the prisoners with their families is already postponed. Keeping in view that there is no depression in the prisoners, the frequency and facility of PCO, PNT phone, CUG talk has been increased.
- Supervision of all the works is being done 24 hours continuously by forming a team under the supervision of Deputy Inspector General of Prisons (M) / Nodal Officer.
- Awareness is being spread among prisoners and personnel for prevention of infection through flex, banner, public address system and jail radio in prisons. The prisoners are constantly being motivated for washing hands and social distancing.
- Everyday cleaning and sanitization work is being done in each jail.
- According to the advisory of the Ministry of AYUSH, arrangements have also been made to provide Ayurvedic decoction to all the prisoners daily.
- Ensure compliance of TTT (Testing, Tracing and Treatment) policy as per Circular No.-21/Sama-1 (Covid-19)/2020, dated 20.11.2020 Issued by the Headquarters.

2. In the said petition, it is to be informed in relation to the paragraph-25 of IA that the Convicted prisoner Baburam Pradhan son of Balwant Jatav, aged about 84 years, resident of Kulla Habibpur police station Sakit, District Etah, Criminal Appeal No.-23/2021, Crime No.-1409/90 S. T. No. 47/1986 u/Section 364, 302/34 of IPC, PS Sakit was put in District Jail, Etah for undergoing sentence of life imprisonment on 06.02.2021.

During the detention in the prison, the first dose of Covid-19 vaccine was given on 08.03.2021 and the second dose on 23.04.2021. The prisoner Baburam was admitted to the Jail Hospital on 09.05.2021 due the problem of Generalized Weakness, but due to low oxygen level, he was sent to the District Hospital, Etah for specific treatment. Covid-19 antigen test was done at District Hospital, Etah, which was found negative. During the treatment, the fact that the jail warden, Shri Ashok Kumar Yadav, posted for the custody of the said prisoner, was noticed of keeping him tied to the bed, the said prison warden/officer was dismissed by order dated 14.05.2021 of the Appointing Officer, Senior Superintendent, Central Prison, Agra (Copy of order enclosed). Due to the deteriorating health of the prisoner, in consultation with the specialist doctor of the District Hospital, Etah, the said prisoner was admitted to U.P.U.M.S., Saifai, Etawah for better treatment. during its treatment, on 17.05.2021 at around 15:20, the prisoner died.

3. It is noteworthy that for the premature release of convicted prisoners detained in the jails of Uttar Pradesh, under the rules established by law are constantly considered. Copies of the guidelines regarding the procedure being followed in respect of premature release are enclosed.

With regard to para-12(11) of IA0 filed in the Suo Moto petition in question, it is to be informed that In compliance with the order dated on 04.05.2021 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court, New Delhi in the writ petition (Cr) No.155/2021 Bechelal vs. U.P. State and in other connected writ petitions, the Member Secretary, Uttar Pradesh State Legal Services Authority attached the instructions of Hon'ble Executive Chairman, UPSLSA and sent it for guidance. It is also noteworthy that during the Covid-19 transition from March 2020 to April 2021, orders for the premature release of total -497 convicted prisoners have been passed.

- In view of the pandemic of Covid-19, at present, there is an effective control on the situation of corona infection in the jails of the state and regular monitoring is also being done on it.
- In order to reduce overcrowding, in the sequence of the recommendations of the High-Powered Committee constituted in compliance of the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the prisoners detained in the jail are being released on interim bail and special parole.
